THINK ABOUT IT THIS WEEK

Reflection Questions

- What small but faithful step is God calling me to take this week?
- How can I trust that God is at work even when I don't see immediate results?

A Prayer for This Week

God of small beginnings, you take what is tiny and make it great. Help me to trust that even my smallest acts of love, faith, and kindness matter in Your Kin-dom. Give me eyes to see where You are working and courage to plant seeds of hope, knowing that You bring the growth. Amen.

Final Thought

This week, don't underestimate what God can do through you. A simple act, a kind word, a prayerful moment—these are the seeds that God uses to grow something far greater than we can see. Keep planting, keep trusting, and watch how God moves!

Two men walk into the temple to pray—one boasts about his goodness, the other simply asks for mercy. Which one does God honor?
